### The traditional BSN program is designed for students who:

- have completed 58 semester hours of required general education courses from any accredited college or university
  - have a minimum 2.5 GPA on their prerequisite coursework
  - have a minimum 2.5 GPA on their cumulative undergraduate coursework
  - have scored a 65% or above on the ATI TEAS test
- 
- The traditional BSN program is designed to be completed in 2 years.
  - Application deadline: **March 1st**
  - Traditional BSN program only admits once a year.
  - Admission based off of the Fall GPA
  - Interview may be required as part of the admission process.
